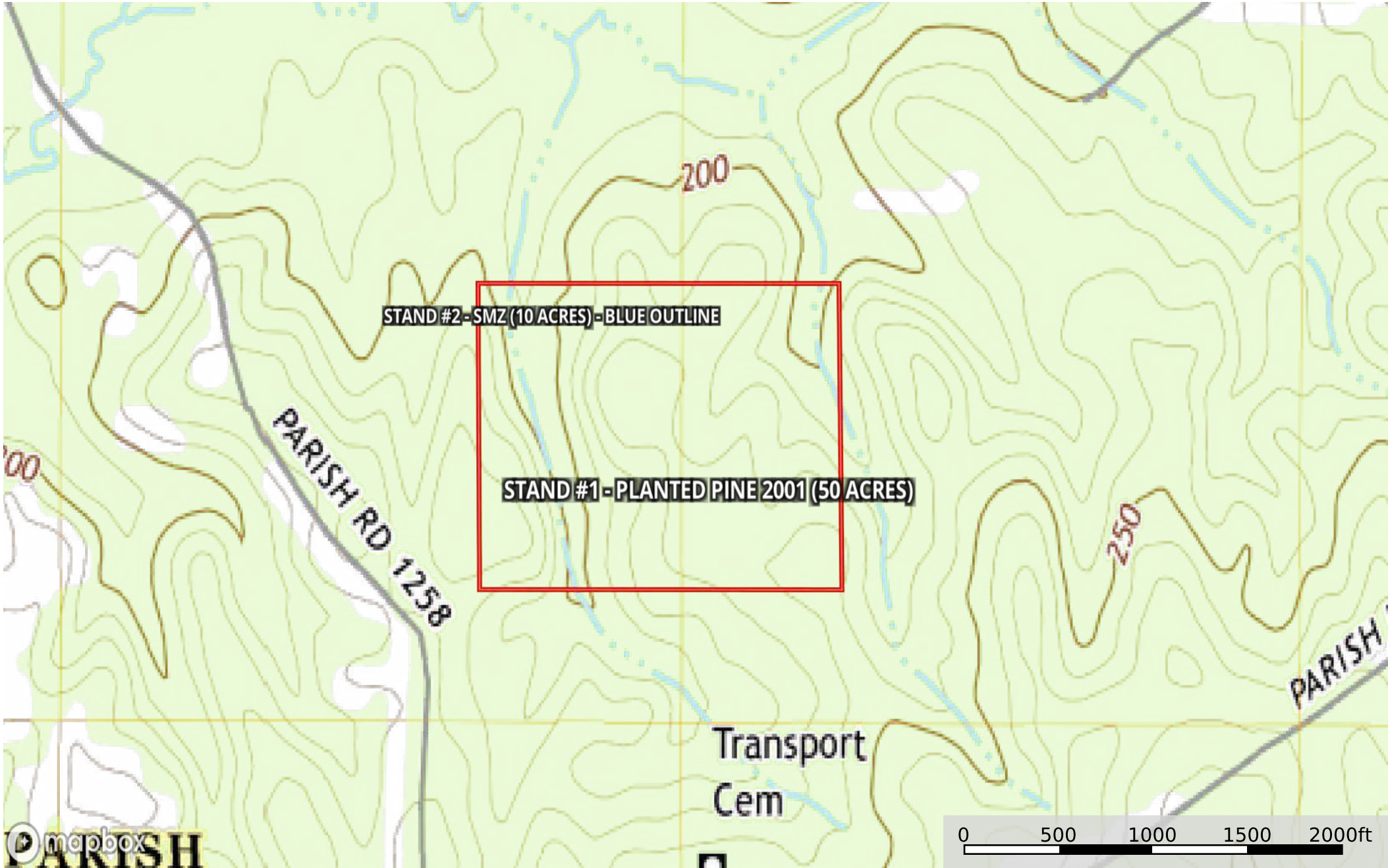


STAND #2 - SMZ (10 ACRES) - BLUE OUTLINE

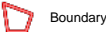
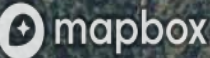
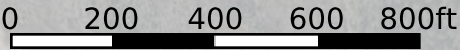
