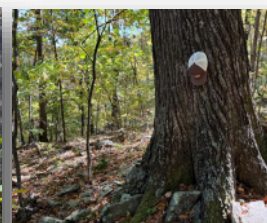


Shenandoah's Edge: 58 Acres of Wild Virginia History

Properties that border Shenandoah National Park rarely come to market. This one embodies the spirit of being “so far away, yet so close” — offering unmatched privacy and access to the wild, while still within reach of Charlottesville's conveniences and charm. Whether you're seeking a hunting retreat, a mountain getaway, or a piece of Virginia history, this property delivers a story worth continuing.
